PWRDF-- On Monday June 14th Heather Carr & Ann Wetherilt joined with other PWRDF reps at the Christ Church Cathedral for a Pot Luck Supper and presentation from PWRDF Coordinator Suzanne Rumsey. Suzanne and her bike "Olive" left General Synod in Halifax on June 9th and are travelling to Quebec by June 26th, stopping at intervals to bring recognition to the work of PWRDF. Suzanne has been with PWRDF for nine years and until April 1, 2010 was the Latin American Coordinator. She now is the Public Engagement Coordinator. Her presentation introduced us to the work being done with partnering organizations in Latin America, Africa, Canada and Asia Pacific. PWRDF's mainstay is humanitarian response and relief work. Our latest endeavour was in response to the earthquake in Haiti. PWRDF has branched out in many other areas of humanitarian work and has introduced a youth program to their agenda. PWRDF works in partnership with ACT (Act with Churches Together) and with CIDA (Canadian International Development Agency).
